

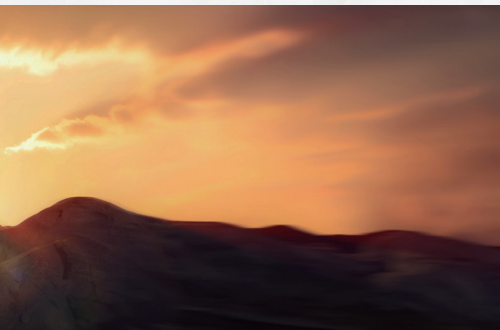
JESUS'

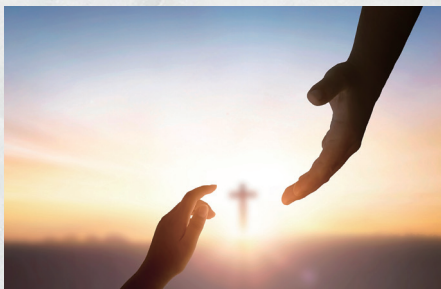
JESUS IS THE SALVATION
